Responsibilities:

- Administer exams and assign work outside the classroom
- Report mid-term and final exam grades within College-specified timelines
- Maintain regular availability to support students

Minimum requirements:

- Master's Degree required in Accounting or a related field.
- Demonstrated ability to foster positive interactions with diverse populations.
- Must be able to perform duties within the normal bounds of a classroom environment.
- Ability to offer the course online.

Course Description:

ACCT 523: This course covers individual tax planning strategies, basics of mergers and acquisitions, asset acquisition, use and disposition, tax accounting methods, trusts, tax-exempt organizations, and tax research techniques.
