The Department of Teacher Education invites applications for an Assistant Professor position. This is a full-time term contract position that will begin in August 2024.

Position Requirements and Responsibilities:

- Teaching experience at the elementary level in Mathematics, or STEM Education, and/or Special Education required; and teaching experience at the collegiate level
- Creating course syllabi and developing instructional materials
- Advising students and serving in a mentorship capacity
- Supervising clinical placement candidates and/or associate teachers at local schools
- Effectively instructing undergraduate and graduate courses in a variety of topics
- Maintaining personal and professional scholarly contributions and provide service to the Department

Minimum Requirements:

- Ph.D. or Ed.D.; ABD will also be considered
- 10+ years teaching experience at the PK-12 level
- Ability to use technology in the classroom

Desired Qualifications:

- Demonstrated effectiveness in teaching
- Demonstrated ability to collaboratively work with faculty, staff, and students
- Strong verbal and written communication skills and strong time management/organizational skills
- Hold Endorsements in Literacy and/or Leadership to support graduate programs
- Solid professional disposition abilities
