Method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under section 18004(a)(1):

Adrian College first determined those students who were eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (not all students were eligible). The specific grant amount disbursed then considered factors including, but not limited to, each student's individual cost of for the 2020-2021 academic year, including institutional aid grants and scholarships received, and Expected Family Contribution as determined through FAFSA submission. Funds were then allocated proportionately as a grant to students for any component of their cost of attendance at Adrian College or for emergency costs that are due to coronavirus. An institutional application was also made available for additional requests.
